

EU Solidarity Fund - Thresholds for major disasters applicable in 2024

based on 2022 Gross National Income (GNI) figures from Eurostat, except for AL, BG, ME, MK, RO and TR**

For the mobilisation of the EU Solidarity Fund[1] country-specific thresholds apply, whereby total direct damage must exceed 0.6% of GNI or € 3 billion in 2011 prices. The lower amount applies.
