Introduction to the topic

The 8th Cohesion Report has identified a set of challenges including demographic change and increased (skills) shortages on the labour market, climate transition, technological change or globalisation. These will unevenly impact, regions and territories – economic, social and territorial disparities are likely to be perennial and might accelerate the development of new disparities between and within Member States. Cohesion Policy promotes the resilience of vulnerable regions, and the catching up of less developed regions and it invests in the resilience of people and disadvantaged groups. It is therefore necessary to better identify both the structural sources of new disparities and the policy mechanisms that can overcome these. These would be discussed through two interlinked sessions dealing with resilience-enhancing strategies but also on tailored support needed for regions with specific challenges. The third meeting will focus on discussion how can Cohesion Policy become even better in tailoring support according to specific development needs and expected impacts of transitions and external shocks.
